Minimum Completion Percentage (MCP)

The Minimum Completion Percentage is the percentage of coursework that a student must earn during enrollment. This component requires ElizabethtownCollege students to earn passing grades in at least, 67% of utmeilativecourse credit hours attempted.

Minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA)

Students must satisfy the qualitative portion of Satisfactory Academic Progress regulations by maintaining the minimulive grander point average accepted as described below.

- V 1.7 after up to 18 credits have been completed but before 19 credits have been completed
- V 1.9 after 19 credits have been completed but before 35 credits have been completed
- V 2.0 between the time that 35 credits have been completed and the student graduates

Proper withdrawal frond ay classes during the first four weeks of a termwill not affect the cumulative grade point average. Incomplete courses do not earn credit or influence the grade point argen the semester in which the course is incomplete; however, they are counted once they are completed.
